The nurse who served in the military has a contribution to make as well. Every nurse makes a difference in the lives of those they touch and those around them.

Apply lessons learned from nursing history to living nurses who are contributing to the history of nursing through an interview and documentation of historical information. Obtain permission from the selected nurse to conduct an interview about the nurse's memories of nhs fpx 6008 developing a business case and nursing education; contributions to nursing; and persons or events that have influenced her or his nursing practice. Complete the NR 393 Course Project Milestone 1 Template (Links to an external site) and submit it by Sunday end of Week 6 with your instructor's approval.

NR 4000 Assessment 3

Medication errors can have severe consequences for patients. Nurses take an oath to cause no harm and patient safety is compromised when nurses make medication mistakes. Medication errors can be prevented or at least minimized by implementing policies that promote safe medication handling processes in hospitals.

The NR 4000 assessment 3 asks students to explore and analyze a health care problem or issue and propose a solution that would address the issue. The assessment also requires students to identify groups of people who might benefit from the proposed solution and NR 351 Week 2 Time Management Plan Assignment the potential ethical implications if the solution were implemented.

The selected issue for this assessment is limited access to healthcare. Many individuals experience a lack of access to healthcare due to cost, shortage of specialists, and geographical disadvantages. This problem affects vulnerable populations including racial and ethnic minorities.

NR 6004 Policy Proposal

Health care providers are facing a challenging economic environment. To address this challenge, it is important to identify an opportunity for improved economic performance in your organization. This can be at a micro (departmental, neighborhood) or macro (organizational, community) level. Your assignment should include a description of the opportunity and an analysis of its potential impact on your department and the organization overall.

You should also consider environmental factors that could affect the implementation of your recommended strategies. For example, how might the NR 393 Week 2 Milestone budget, staffing, and logistics influence your implementation? Additionally, you should identify colleagues, individual stakeholders, or stakeholder groups who may be able to contribute to the development and implementation of your policy. Finally, you should present your findings in a professional and persuasive manner.

NR 6008 Developing a Business Case

As a health care administrator, you must develop a business case for an initiative that provides ethical and culturally equitable improvements to the quality of patient care. Your proposal must address the economic impact of the project at both the micro (departmental, neighborhood) and macro (organizational, community) levels. You must also identify potential risks and costs associated with the proposed initiative.

For example, the Tiptop Medical Centre has noticed a reduction in its clientele since the establishment of a competitor that offers similar services to critical patients. To overcome this challenge, the facility plans to create a coordination office that will offer its clients total facilitation for emergency cases. This will make the facility more appealing to its clients (Fuchs & Diamantopoulos, 2010). The implementation of this initiative will also provide an additional revenue source for the hospital.
